

Overview

Morwenstow (<u>Cornish</u>: *Logmorwenna*) is a <u>civil parish</u> in north <u>Cornwall</u>, England, United Kingdom. The parish abuts the west coast, about six miles (10 km) north of <u>Bude</u> and within the <u>Cornwall Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty</u> (AONB).

Morwenstow is the most northerly parish in <u>Cornwall</u>. As well as the <u>churchtown</u> (a hamlet called Crosstown), other settlements in the parish include <u>Shop</u>, <u>Woodford</u>, <u>Gooseham</u>, <u>Eastcott</u>, <u>Woolley</u> and <u>West Youlstone</u>. It also is the location for GCHQ Bude The population at the 2011 census was 791. Morwenstow parish is bounded to the north and east by parishes in <u>Devon</u>, to the south by <u>Kilkhampton</u> parish and to the west by the <u>Atlantic</u>. The <u>River Tamar</u> has its source at a spring on Woolley Moor, at 50.9235°N 4.4622°W, which is in the parish near the border with Devon.

The main North Cornwall link road (A39) also passes through the Parish The predominant industry is Agriculture

First things to do in the event of an emergency:

- 1. Ring 999 to inform the Emergency Services and provide:
- Clear
- Concise
- Actual information as soon as possible
- 2. Contact the plan coordinators
- 3. Meet at the coordinator's assembly point
- 4. When the Emergency services arrive, they will assume sole jurisdiction over the incident

In the event that the above location is inaccessible the following will be used:

Woodford Chapel, Woodville Rd, Woodford. EX23 9JA Grid ref: S221975.113608 What 3 words: reforming . dividers . slumped

The coordinator and plan group may then decide to:

- Agree locations and open Evacuation Assembly Points (if required).
- Contact volunteers with specific skills, equipment or resources who may be able to assist with the emergency situation.

• Contact other plan volunteers as required.

Activating the community emergency plan

Until help arrives and without endangering yourself or other people contact the appropriate members of the community and ask them to report to the agreed assembly point.

When the emergency services or other responders have arrived try and make contact with them, explain who you are and what your role is.

- The plan can be activated by the emergency coordinator based on that person's assessment of the situation. It is easier to stop the plan should events come under control sooner than expected than not to respond at all.
- Sometimes full plan activation will not be required and the plan should also be seen as a resource to solve smaller issues within the community.
- If details of an incident are received from a source other than the emergency services or local authority then those receiving the notification must contact the emergency services to ensure they are aware of the incident. This may require making a 999 call.


