Terms and conditions of use

Before connecting to the Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi, please read this document (terms and conditions of use) carefully.

Wi-Fi Internet access is provided free of charge to legitimate users of the Community Centre.

These Terms along with our Privacy Policy make up the terms and conditions for use of the Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi.

We may make changes to these Terms from time to time, so we recommend that you review these regularly. The terms - *we, our, us, you, your, yours, and buyer* - when used in this document refer to you as a user of Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi.

By connecting to Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi, you accept these Terms, you acknowledge that you have read and understood, and you agree to all the terms.

1. Using Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi

- Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi is a free service available to Morwenstow Community centre users and is provided by Morwenstow Parish Council. You can continue to use Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi free of charge as long as you continue to accept the following terms and conditions.
- If you are in Morwenstow Community Centre you can connect to the Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi using a compatible phone or computer device with wireless LAN. We do not guarantee that Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi is compatible with all hardware types and devices or guarantee device connectivity.
- To connect to Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi you will not need to provide any personal information however details from the device you are using to connect to our network may be recorded.
- Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi is intended for browsing the internet, emails and using apps.
- We are not responsible for the content of any websites you visit while using Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi. We may at our sole discretion restrict access to certain features and websites. If you have any concerns about this or require any further information you can contact clerk@morwenstowparish.gov.uk
- We do not guarantee uninterrupted access to Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi, and we may suspend the service at any time, for any reason, in our sole discretion.

- Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi is not a secure network, and we are not responsible for the security of the information and data which you transmit using Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi.
- We are not responsible for the accuracy of any information or data obtained from the internet using Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi.
- The use of Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi is entirely at the risk of the user. As such, we strongly recommend that your device has up-to-date anti-virus and all security upgrades prior to any usage.

2. How we use your information

- By using Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi you agree that your device details may be stored.
- We reserve the right to report on any activity undertaken on Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi and where necessary restrict or block access to a person, account, website, or device.

3. Our liability to you

- Nothing in these Terms shall restrict nor exclude our liability for death or personal injury arising from our negligence or our liability for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation nor any other liability which cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law.
- We shall not be liable to you in contract, tort (including negligence), breach of statutory duty or otherwise arising for:
 - ~ loss of income or revenue.
 - ~ loss of business.
 - ~ loss of profits or contracts.
 - ~ loss of anticipated savings.
 - ~ loss of opportunity or goodwill.
 - ~ loss of, damage to, or corruption, of data; or
 - ~ indirect or consequential loss of any kind.

4. What you MUST NOT do on Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi (this list is not exhaustive)

You agree to the following:

- You MUST NOT use Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi for any unlawful or illegal purpose
- You MUST NOT make any use of Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi which causes the whole or part of Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi to be interrupted, damaged, made less efficient, or impair the effectiveness or functionality of Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi in any way
- You MUST NOT use Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi for sending or posting any computer viruses or any other harmful code, or any material which is defamatory, offensive, or obscene; or
- You MUST NOT use Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi in a way which infringes the rights of any person (whether in breach of confidentiality or intellectual property rights or otherwise).
- You MUST NOT create, download, store, transmit or display material that promotes or incites hatred, terrorism or hate crimes.
- You MUST NOT forge header information, email source address or other user information or use another person's name, username, or password for fraudulent purposes
- You MUST NOT access, monitor or use any data, systems, or networks, including another person's private information, without authority or attempt to probe, scan, or test the vulnerability of any data, system, or network or to violate the privacy, publicity, or other

personal rights of others or to impair the privacy of communications in any way that harms or attempts to harm minors, young people, or vulnerable adults

- You MUST NOT visit, download, or transmit from sites that are deemed inappropriate or offensive, pornographic, or that contain material of an obscene nature. Any user who inadvertently accesses an inappropriate Internet site must immediately close the session or return to the previous page

The Wi-Fi network connection may be subject to monitoring, with cause, for security, legal, or troubleshooting purposes. We reserve the right to monitor Wi-Fi activity, terminate, or restrict your access to Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi, without advance notice, if we reasonably believe that you are misusing Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi or are otherwise in breach of these Terms.

5. Indemnity

- You agree to indemnify and hold us and our subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, agents, and employees harmless from and against all liabilities, claims, losses or damages (including legal fees) costs and other expenses, however caused, that may arise as a result of or in connection with inappropriate or unauthorised access to Morwenstow Community Centre Wi-Fi by you and/or breach by you of any of these Terms.

6. General

- If any part or provision of these Terms are found to be unlawful or unenforceable (including any provision in which we exclude our liability to you), the enforceability of any other party of these Terms will not be affected.
- These Terms are governed by English law and subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
