HAMLETS

The monthly Parish Council meeting was held on Wednesday 16th February 2022 in the Community Centre. Present were Cllrs. J Hobbs (Chair), K Boundy, J Phipps, R Savage, N Steer, S Tilbey, G Worden & K Jones, A Whittle (Bude Area Community Network Panel) one member of the public and Mrs S Rosser (Clerk). Apologies were accepted from Cllr. J Payne, S Beesley (Bude Area Community Network Panel) & Rev T Folland.

Alan Whittle gave a short presentation to those present, highlighting the challenges that the network has faced in the last two years, along with the accomplishments that have been achieved. Alan asked for agenda items to be put forward for future meetings and reminded everyone that the meetings are open to all. The meetings are currently held on Microsoft Teams – next meeting date is Monday 7th March at 7pm.

County Cllr. Tilbey outlined his recent duties as Ward member. One of which included engaging with school children at Kilkhampton Primary School, along with MP Scott Mann. The Cornwall Council Highways budget setting process is underway. This is also the case for Devolution Levelling Up.

Community Grants were awarded to the Morwenstow Methodist Church & Woodford Chapel.

Platinum Jubilee Celebrations were discussed - events planned include: Thursday 2nd June – Bell ringing and Jubilee beacon lighting. Friday 3rd June, Women of Woodford will hold a street party. There will be a 'Bring and Share Picnic' on Saturday 4th June, with the metric band. Oak trees are to be ordered, along with red, white and blue wild flower seed mixes for sewing on verges. Mugs will be purchased for children in the parish aged 0 – 16. This will require registration of each child by parents/guardians - more details to follow. Cllr. J Phipps is heading up a working party to further plans.

One expression of interest has been received for the vacancy for a co-opted Parish Councillor. There were 31 items of correspondence noted. These can be found in further detail on our website.

To remove overgrown vegetable patch and construct a wooden garden building in its place using natural wood cladding at Quillers Wind Gooseham Bude Cornwall EX23 9PF. *Morwenstow Parish Council would like to support this application.* PA21/06671; Erection of annexe ancillary to 3 Jaques Cottages at Land North Of 3 Jaques Cottages Morwenna Road Shop Morwenstow Cornwall EX23 9SW. *Morwenstow Parish Council still find themselves unable to support this application.* PA21/09031; Retention of temporary worker's dwelling at South Woolley Stables Morwenstow Bude Cornwall EX23 9PP. *Morwenstow Parish Council would like to support this application.*

The next regular Parish Council meeting will be held on Wednesday 16th March 2022.
