The monthly meeting of the Parish Council was held on Wednesday 16th July 2025. Attended by: Cllrs. J Hobbs (Chair) J Phipps, N Steer, J Payne, G Worden, R Savage, C Myers, J Amos-Yeo, & the Clerk – S Rosser. Apologies were received and accepted from S Tilbey & Cornwall Councillor F Emery. Three members of the public also attended.

A written report was read by the Clerk from Cornwall Councillor Faye Emery – this can be found in full in the draft minutes on the website.

The usual maintenance matters were covered. A footpath report had been received by a member of the public regarding Hackmarsh to Marsland Water – this was investigated by Cllr. Steer. The usual maintenance checks of the trees, playpark, overall grounds, and fitness equipment were checked and signed off.

There will be an opening event for the new facilities on Sunday 7th September between 2pm & 5pm. Please keep an eye on the website and Facebook pages for more details as and when available. Everything is coming together now and bookings will soon be able to be made to hire the games court and equipment.

The new 'Hawker Country' sign has also been installed. An editorial piece written by Alan Rowland has been sent photos to the local Bude & Stratton post for publication.

Hedge trimming:

For anyone with overgrown hedges that impede vision -please address this with utmost importance.

Information below is taken from Cornwall Councils website:

- Landowners may cut the verge as well as their hedges. Individuals also cut verges in the vicinity of their properties for aesthetic purposes.
- Hedge growth or trees on properties next to the highway is generally the responsibility of the landowner.
- We recommend that regular maintenance of hedgerows is undertaken.
- Regular maintenance prevents side growth and low-lying branches extending into the road. Landowners must take reasonable care to ensure that trees within falling distance of the highway are safe.

A date for your calendar. We are holding the Morwenstow Ceilidh/Barn Dance again this year Saturday 15th November 2025. See the poster for details. This year we are fundraising for the replacement equipment for the Morwenstow AED's (Automated Electronic Defibrillators).

This year so far, I have asked the MUC to fund:-

6 x Pad Sets for the AED's in Gooseham, Woolley, The Bush Inn at a cost of £59 each = £354 + postage.

1 Starter Kit - at £10

2 sets of Pads for the Shop AED = £141

The pads expire approximately every 2 1/2 years.

If the pads & a starter kit are used in an emergency they also have to be replaced.

About every 4 years the batteries have to be replaced (sooner if the AED is used) and a replacement is £205 to £324 + postage.

So, the MUC funds will soon be depleted if no fundraising happens for the Charity.


