HAMLETS

The monthly meeting of the Parish Council was held on Wednesday 18th June 2025. Attended by: Cllrs. J Hobbs (Chair) J Phipps, N Steer, K Jones, J Payne, G Worden, S Tilbey, C Myers, J Amos-Yeo, Cornwall Councillor F Emery & the Clerk – S Rosser. Apologies were received and accepted from R Savage. Four members of the public also attended.

Cornwall Councillor Faye gave a report which included the number 12 bus changes; Cornwall Council reversing the decision to sell off its carparks. The North Cornwall Community Area Partnership meeting had also taken place. The two themes that are a focus are health and wellbeing along with transport.

The usual maintenance matters were covered. The signs for the prevention of overnight parking on Crosstown green were resolved, along with new 'no dog' signs for the Playing Fields. A smaller Union Flag is being purchased along with a flag of St. Piran. Details were furthered for the welcome pack which will available as a pdf download on the website. This is hoped to be available in early Autumn. Funding has now been offered for the remaining items in the Health & Wellbeing Project - items are on order. Councillors are completing their Code of Conduct courses, in line with the new Council term requirements. The advertisement for the Clerk/R.F.O role was also discussed. PA25/03276|Proposed slurry lagoon (SIG)|Cory Farm Morwenstow Bude Cornwall EX23 9ST MPC Comments: Morwenstow Parish Council have no objections to the application; providing it is built to the specification of the standards set out, by the appropriate governing body. Thank you. No further applications were discussed.

Clerk/RFO Information

Morwenstow Parish Council consists of 10 Councillors and the Clerk/RFO. For the 2025-2029 Term of Office 9 of the Councillors were elected and one seat is currently vacant. The co-option process has begun, it is anticipated that the vacancy will be filled before this post is taken up.

Meetings are held in the Community Centre, Shop, Morwenstow, EX23 9SL. Monthly meetings are held on the third Wednesday of every month at 7.30pm, excluding August and December.

The Annual Parish Council Meeting is held on the third Wednesday of May at 7.30pm and is followed by the monthly meeting.

The Annual Parish Meeting is held on the fourth Wednesday of May at 7.00pm (this can change in an election year, if necessary).

Extra Planning meetings; if necessary, are held on the first Wednesday of the month at 7.00pm.

Agendas, Minutes and relevant notices are posted on the Parish Council website and are also displayed in the Parish Council notice board; by the Clerk, this is attached to the wall of the Men's Institute building in Shop.

A date for your calendar. We are holding the Morwenstow Ceilidh/Barn Dance again this year Saturday 15th November 2025. See the poster for details. This year we are fundraising for the replacement equipment for the Morwenstow AED's (Automated Electronic Defibrillators).

This year so far, I have asked the MUC to fund:-

6 x Pad Sets for the AED's in Gooseham, Woolley, The Bush Inn at a cost of £59 each = £354 + postage.

1 Starter Kit - at £10

2 sets of Pads for the Shop AED = £141

The pads expire approximately every 2 1/2 years.

If the pads & a starter kit are used in an emergency they also have to be replaced.

About every 4 years the batteries have to be replaced (sooner if the AED is used) and a replacement is £205 to £324 + postage.

So, the MUC funds will soon be depleted if no fundraising happens for the Charity.




