HAMLETS

The annual meeting of the Parish Council was held on Wednesday 14th May 2025; it was immediately followed by the monthly meeting. Attended by: Cllrs. J Hobbs (Chair) J Phipps, N Steer, K Jones, J Payne, G Worden, R Savage, C Myers, J Amos-Yeo, Cornwall Councillor F Emery & the Clerk – S Rosser. Apologies were received from S Tilbey. One member of the public also attended.

Cllr J Hobbs was unanimously elected to be Chairman for the year; Cllr J Phipps will also continue to be Vice-Chair. A full list of Councillor portfolios can be found online, in the full minutes of the annual meeting.

Our newly elected ward member for Stratton, Kilkhampton & Morwenstow was in attendance. Cornwall Councillor Faye Emery introduced herself and looks forward to working with the Parish Council for the next 4 years.

The usual maintenance matters were covered. Overnight parking on Crosstown green continues to be a problem. The original sign had been re-erected; but has now disappeared. The Council will need to purchase another sign – again all are reminded that any green in the Parish is not to be parked on. The RoSPA report was received on the day of the meeting; this will be discussed in full at the June meeting, although any urgent action required has been taken. The Council are going put together a new resident welcome pack that will be available online. The idea of this is to promote all of the activities available in the Parish, helping them to continue to grow and remain sustainable. More details will be given once available.

Three planning applications were considered. PA25/02559|Installation of ground mounted solar PV array.| Bush Inn Crosstown Morwenstow Bude Cornwall EX23 9SR. MPC Comments: Whilst the Public Rights of Way team have an objection to this application; the Council are not in agreeance that there remains a deviation, from the existing footpath as there once was. Providing the PROW team can be satisfied - the Parish Council would support this application for renewable energy. Thank you. PA25/02753|Proposed change of use to campsite and glamping with associated works| Land West Of Eastcott Cross Farm House Gooseham Bude Cornwall EX23 9PN. MPC Comments: Morwenstow Parish Council would like to be able to support the business; that is already taking place and is now established. However, before full support can be given - the Council seek clarification on two items. The Council cannot recollect the additional three dwellings mentioned in the application, therefore request clarification on those from the Planning Officer please. Secondly, when a query was raised with the Parish Council in relation to this site - it was in relation to another element of development here. The Council respectfully ask for assurance as to whether there is a subsequent application forthcoming, to cover those additional works? Thank you. PA25/03137|Change of use from holiday let to unfettered residential dwelling| Tricks Cottage Morwenstow Bude Cornwall EX23 9PP. MPC Comments: Morwenstow Parish Council have no objections to this application. Thank you.
