
Join Bude Choral Society for an enchanting evening of Mozart and Haydn at St Michael's Church, Bude on Saturday, March 29th at 7:00 PM.

The programme features Mozart's magnificent Solemn Vespers and Organ Mass in C, alongside Haydn's celebrated Maria Theresa Mass. As you may all be aware, Morwenstow now have defibrillators sited in Shop, Eastcott, Woolley, Gooseham and Cross Town, and one soon to be installed in Woodford.

This is a tremendous achievement since, Brad Olde, a local young fit 20yr old man, who had a cardiac arrest in 2015, and survived through life saving skills of CPR and emergency defibrillator.

We therefore felt it right to provide an **Awareness Day** on basic life saving skills for everyone from secondary school age and upwards. This will include, how and when to use a defibrillator plus Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR).

This will be presented by Jay's Aim, with video and hands on manikins to practice on. Plus a chance to get your blood pressure checked. You will also be encouraged to ask as many questions as possible.

EAST YOULSTONE COMMUNITY BENEFIT FUND



Fund Overview

The East Youlstone Community Benefit Fund, in Devon, has £15,000 available per year for community projects.

The Fund allows groups to apply for grants between £250 and £7,500.

There is one application round each year. The application closing date for 2025 is 26 March.

Project Purpose

Priority will be given to:

- Energy efficiency or renewable energy projects, such as insulation, efficient boilers or small scale renewable energy installations.
- Training or education projects, especially vocational training for unemployed young people aged under 25.
- · Projects for school age children, or older people.
- Any other community projects for the benefit of residents of the local area.

Eligible Organisations

Eligible Organisations, who can apply for funding include:

- Voluntary, community groups
- Parish Councils
- Schools and educational establishments
- Social enterprises and Community Interest Companies operating on a non-profit-distributing basis.
 These are defined by Social UK as 'businesses that trade to tackle social problems, improve
 communities, people's life chances, or the environment. They make their money from selling goods
 and services in the open market, but they reinvest their profits back into the business or the local
 community'.

These organisations must have a minimum of three unrelated Directors, that also do not reside at the same address.

Applicants are required to have a written constitution, a set of rules, or a governing document and a bank or building society account, held in the name of the organisation, in place before applying for a grant.

Organisations that have already received grants from the Fund can apply for further grants each year.


